Natural wonder and a journey through time into the history of the earth

Detailed description

The **Bürs Gorge** is one of the most impressive natural landscapes in the Alps. Over thousands of years, the interplay of ice and water has formed a breathtaking gorge landscape, which creates a unique atmosphere with its almost primeval forest-like tree population.

After the retreat of the glaciers, the **Alvier stream** dug deep into its own gravel, creating today's gorge over the last 10,000 years. This natural monument provides fascinating insights into the recent **history of the earth** and is also a habitat for **extraordinary flora and fauna**.

A visit to the Bürs Gorge is a special experience - here geology, history and untouched nature merge into an impressive overall experience.

Length: 5 km

Walking time: 2 h

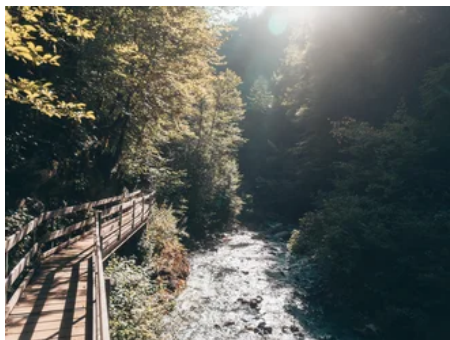
Refreshment stops: Inns in Bürs and Bürserberg
